## A Message from the Board of Directors

The McKinleyville Community Services District Board of Directors accepted Director Helen Edwards' resignation at the July 2016 Board Meeting. Everyone at the District would like to thank Director Edwards' commitment to serving her community on the MCSD Board since 2007.

The Board has decided to fill the vacant Board Seat in a Mail In Ballot Election in March 2017, which has given the District, the County Elections Office and interested candidates more time to get their paperwork in order. Once the County Elections Office releases the Election Calendar, District staff will make it available on our website. Candidates must live within the District's Boundaries and be registered voters.

In order for there to be an election in March 2017 there must be at least two candidates. In the event there are not two candidates, the seat will be filled by a Board of Supervisor's appointment.

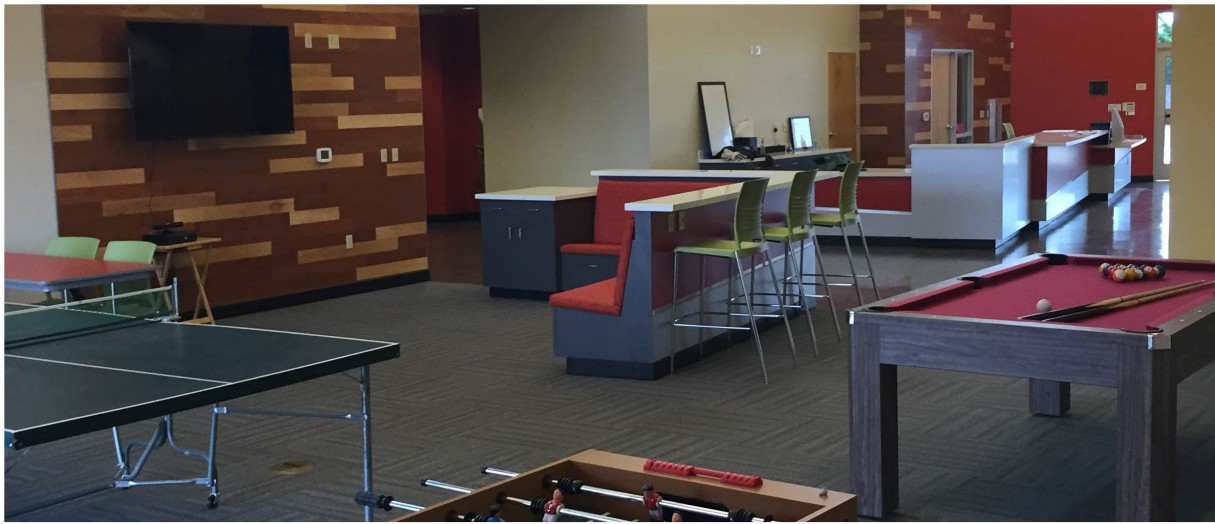

# Teen & Community Center Update

The McKinleyville Teen & Community Center is now constructed and being put to good use! It is open for Middle and High Schoolers Monday to Friday in the afternoon. See the next page for specifics on the CLUB @ the McKinleyville Teen & Community Center run by the Boys & Girls Club of the Redwoods (BGCR). When the Center is not being used by BGCR it is available for: leisure classes, recreation programs, and rentals by individuals and organizations.

The center is a 6,600 square foot facility that includes a quiet study room, a divisible multi-purpose room, a music room, a central game lobby, a covered outdoor performance area and a commercial kitchen to augment an existing area (the Activity Center) that will seat 450 for banquets. The construction and the maintenance of the Center are funded through local ballot Measure B; however, this funding does not include furnishing of the building. MCSD, in partnership with BGCR, has launched a fundraising campaign to gain the funds necessary to furnish the entire building. Through the donations and funds we have raised so far we have been able to purchase the basics to get the center up and running. We still need kitchen supplies, the recording studio equipment, some furniture, and some landscaping. See Page 6 for information on how you can help to furnish the center!

# Boys & Girls Club of the Redwoods

The Boys & Girls Club of the Redwoods has opened the CLUB @ the McKinleyville Teen & Community Center and is currently running their after-school programs for Middle and High Schoolers aged 11 to 18. Although the real cost to cover these programs is \$504 per child per year, BGCR has been able to have the school year Membership fee be \$30.00 per child. Individual and corporate contributions make up the rest of the cost.

Every day members are helped with their homework, participate in organized sports, arts & crafts projects, and enjoy a nutritious snack. The Club focuses on five core areas of development: Sports, Fitness and Social Recreation, Character and Leadership Development, Health and Life Skills, The Arts, and Education and Career. Focusing on these areas provides the children who participate the opportunity to engage in programs that will enable them to develop positive self images and reach their full potential.

Diploma2Degree is a college prep program for 9th to 12th graders. It features tutoring, academic counseling, career development and college research. This program meets on Tuesday and Thursday from 6:00-6:30pm.

Keystone is a program that focuses on leadership and character development, community volunteering, fundraising and features an end of the year trip. Keystone meets Mondays and Wednesdays from 5:00-6:00pm.

Smart Moves is a seminar style program that focuses on physical, emotional and social development while allowing the members to express themselves openly in a positive environment. This program is for 12-14 year olds on Tuesdays & Thursdays at 4:30pm.

Power Snack happens Monday-Thursday and is a 30 minute block of time set aside for Homework/Reading/Quiet Play and a nutritious snack.

# Wastewater Treatment Plant Upgrade

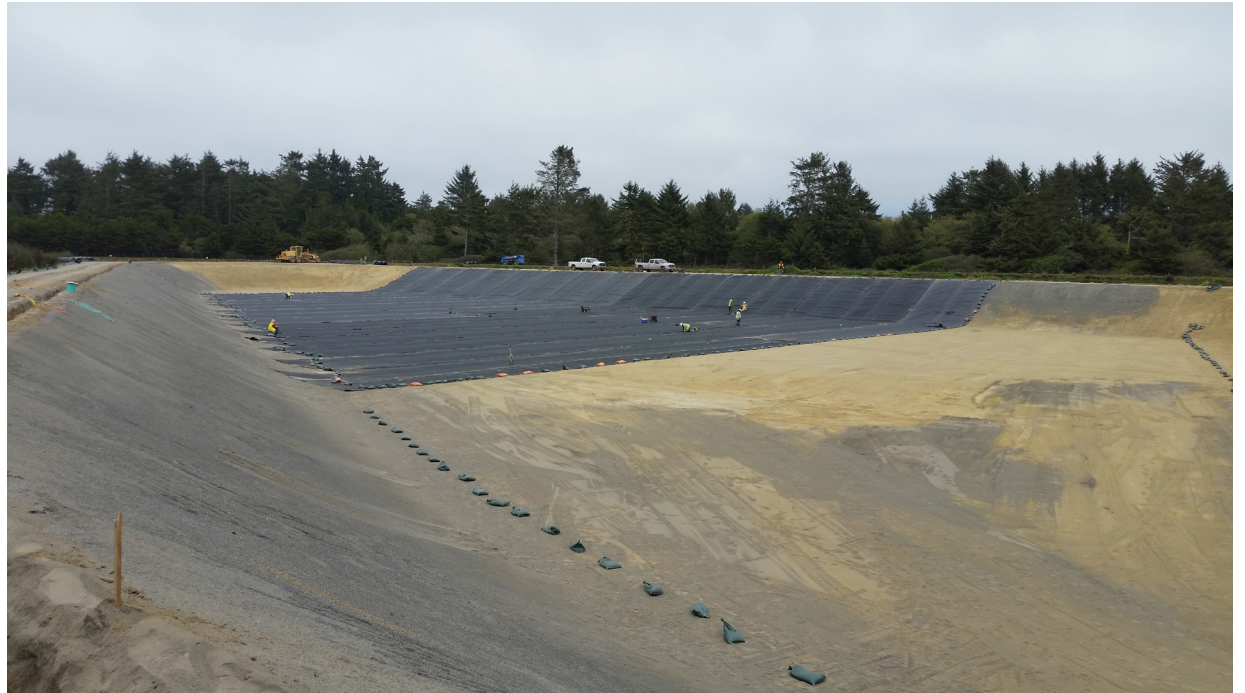
In January 2012 the District completed a 20 Year Wastewater Facilities Plan. The Plan identifies a series of upgrades to the District's existing wastewater treatment plant including portions of the effluent disposal system. The improvements will address the needs for the facility through the year 2030. The Plan recommends replacing the existing facultative lagoon system with an in-basin extended aeration system.

The Wastewater Management Facility improvements include a new headworks facility; aeration basins; a blower/electrical/maintenance building; two new secondary clarifiers, including return activated sludge/waste activated sludge (RAS/WAS) pumping; and a biosolids storage basin.

The District held a Groundbreaking Ceremony on January 19, 2016 for the Wastewater Management Facility Upgrade project. The contract for the Wastewater Management Facility Improvements was awarded to the lowest bidder, Auburn Constructors, Inc. at the December 9, 2015 Special Board Meeting. Auburn Constructors, Inc.'s bid amount is \$12,327,300.00. The preliminary design cost estimate indicated the bid price to be approximately \$13.2 million.

Site work began in March of this year. A time-lapse camera was installed at the plant. It will take snapshots daily to chronicle the progress of construction. Following completion of the new upgrade, a video will be made from the snapshots.

## Water & Sewer Mainline Rehab. Master Plans

The District solicited Requests for Qualifications (RFQ) to address in-the-ground water and wastewater infrastructure upgrades and repairs. These Plans are intended to assist the District in their planning process for the replacement of their aging water and sewer mains and appurtenances as well as address capacity issues associated with community growth. The deadline for submission of RFQs was September 23, 2016. Three proposals were received. Our goal is to determine the most qualified team to provide a comprehensive plan for the long term replacement and rehabilitation of MCSD's eighty plus miles of water main and sixty-five plus miles of sewer main. The process will include review of the proposals and interviews with the most qualified candidates. Upon completion of this project MCSD will have a plan that lays out a procedure for replacement, rehabilitation and upgrade of this critical infrastructure into the future and the costs associated for future rate studies.

IPM is a strategy that focuses on the long-term prevention of pests and their damage through a combination of biological, mechanical, cultural, physical and chemical control methods in a way that minimizes economic, health and environmental risks.

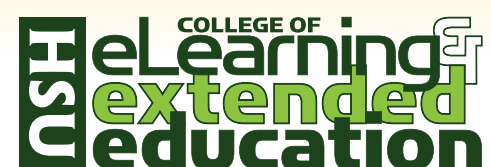

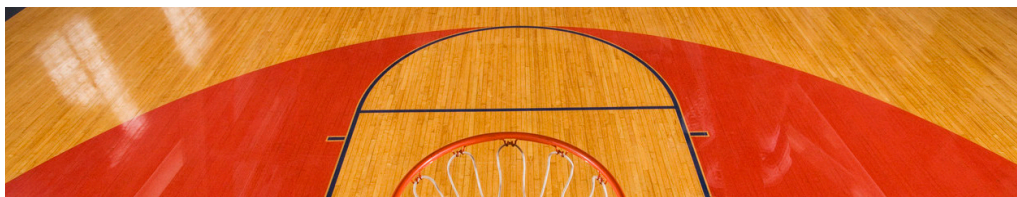
