2012 3 ON 3 BASKETBALL LEAGUE RULES:

1. Each game will be run half court. Baskets made from inside the arc count as two points. Baskets made when the shooter has both feet behind the arc count as three points.
2. Players should wear the same color of shirts for league games. Numbers are not necessary.
3. The winning team will be the team that wins two out of three games. The first team to reach 25 points in a game is the winner of that game.
4. In the case of a tie-breaker (when each team wins one game), the first team to reach 25 (by two points) is the winner.
5. Each team is allowed two (2) 30-second timeout per game.
6. Substitutions are unlimited and may be made only when the ball is dead and out of play.
7. A coin-flip before the game determines the possession of the ball.
8. To start the game, the ball must be passed (NOT DRIBBLED) into play from the top of the key.
9. After each basket or change of possession, the ball must be taken back behind the three-point line. The player must have both feet behind the line.
10. Before the ball is brought into play, it must be “checked” to the defensive team.
11. Ball possession changes hands after each basket unless a foul is awarded. (*Loser's Outs*)
12. There will be no free throws awarded as a result of shooting fouls. After each foul, the team who was fouled will start at the top of the key.
13. Fouls will be called by the player who is fouled. If there are any disagreements, either team may call the gym supervisor to resolve the matter.
14. The gym supervisor shall have the power to make decisions on any points not specifically covered in the rules.
15. Each team will be responsible for keeping score. The score **must be verbally called out after each basket.** **The team that scores a basket returns to defense.**
16. The team captain will represent his/her team as spokesperson at all times.
17. All Jump ball situations will go to the defensive team.
18. Each team may have a minimum of three (3) players and a maximum of eight (8) players on the roster.

2012 3 ON 3 BASKETBALL LEAGUE GUIDELINES

1. The Adult 3 on 3 Basketball League is for players 16 years of age and older. All players are required to sign an agreement waiver and release prior to the start of the first game.
2. Alcoholic beverages and illegal drugs will not be tolerated. Any incidents regarding alcohol or illegal drugs will be referred immediately to the Parks & Recreation Director for immediate action. **Managers are responsible for team members and spectators understanding these rules.**
3. McKinleyville Parks & Recreation is not responsible for injuries to the players or spectators while participating or watching the games in the gym or on the property. All participants in the recreation program do so at their own risk. Players should make arrangements to provide themselves with the necessary insurance coverage for accidental injury.
4. Team managers are responsible for the conduct of all team members and their spectators.
5. Official scorebooks will not be kept by the McKinleyville Parks & Recreation Department. Team scorebooks may be used for your team purposes only. Scores will be submitted to the Recreation Supervisor at the end of each game night.
6. Any fighting before, during or after a game will result in expulsion of those involved without a refund.
7. The use of the McKinleyville Activity Center(Gym) is a privilege and not a right. Please show respect for all property and persons in charge.
8. There will be no inappropriate or offensive language tolerated at any time during league games. A violation of this rule will result in suspension or expulsion of those involved. Violations will be studied and administered by the Director of Parks & Recreation.
9. All protests must be addressed to the Director of Parks & Recreation, c/o McKinleyville Parks & Recreation Department, 1656 Sutter Road, McKinleyville, CA 95519 and must be received no later than 48 hours after the occurrence. Protests concerning judgment calls made by a supervisor or "spotter" are not valid.
 - A) All protests must be specific
 - B) All protests must be submitted in writing
 - C) Decisions of the Advisory Committee will be final.
10. All teams must have three(3) players to begin any contest. A team may end the game with fewer than three players without a forfeit.
11. All league rules will be strictly enforced. All managers must be familiar with any rule changes.
12. Technical fouls for un-sportsmanlike behavior - The gym supervisors are instructed to administer technical fouls for un-sportsmanlike behavior. If a player received two (2) technical fouls in a game, he/she will be removed from the gym after the second technical. If this happens twice in the season, he/she will be removed from league play for the remainder of the season.

Protection of these vital elements serves to eliminate unsportsmanlike conduct from the basketball court. Such actions as taunting opposing players, dangerous aggression, belligerent intimidation, intentional fouls, or other win-at-all-costs behavior are contrary to the 'Spirit of the Game' and must be avoided by all players.
