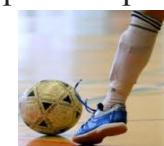

LEISURE CLASSES

Puppy Training

Join experienced instructor Delilah Huck for a six week course designed to help new pet owners deal with and understand normal puppy behaviors that can sometimes be overwhelming and frustrating for the inexperienced puppy owner. Learn the tools for solving problems such as digging, chewing, mouthing, and more. Lessons will include teaching your dog to come, sit down, stand, walk on loose lead, interact with people without jumping, and go to your bed.



Basic Dog Obedience

Join experienced instructor Delilah Huck for a six week course designed to train you to become the leader in your relationship with your dog and train your dog to view you as such. Once accomplished, your dog will begin to look to you for guidance. This class will cover heel on a leash, down stay, sit stay, come when called, down in motion, keeping your dog's attention around distractions, and how to elicit playful behavior from your dog.

Dog Tricks class is a fun and engaging way for dogs and their handlers of all ages to learn a variety of commands not usually covered in an obedience class. Have fun with your dog and develop skills that will help your dog learn! Your dog will learn skills such as: "rollover", "high five", "sit up", "crawl", "bow", and "get in a box".

Dog Life and Social Skills Apr. 15-May 20, 2014

Meets Tuesdays: 6:30pm-7:30pm

This course is designed to use fun games and exercises to develop real-life, practical dog skills for your home, and being in public. These skills include focus on you, leave it, waiting at the door, coming when called, leashing up manners, loose leash walking, meet and greet, wait for the food bowl, stay, go to their bed or mat, and games/tricks. This class will provide both dogs and owners with a foundation of skills that can be used in everyday life. All of these behaviors can be taught through positive training and through activities that strengthen your relationship with your dog.

Agility Foundation Class Jan. 7 - Feb. 11, 2014

This course is designed to teach dogs and handlers foundation behaviors needed to shine in the sport of agility. We work to develop and improve skills such as cueing your dog to move with you, read your motion, clicker/yes training, crate games, come with speed, nose touch circle work and tug. We work on different surfaces and do tricks; All things important for agility!

Leader-In-Training (LIT) Program

Get a jumpstart on developing leadership skills in this great volunteer program for teens age 13 and up. LIT's serve at the Kids' Camp Summer Day Camp program as assistants to our Recreation Leaders; helping lead games, teaching arts & crafts, leading song circles, and more. The LIT Program is a great way for teens to gain valuable work experience in a fun and supportive atmosphere.

LIT's must commit to a minimum of 3 weeks of camp, volunteering Monday-Friday for each of the 3 weeks. Full day or half day scheduling is available.

LIT's must attend pre-camp training (dates TBA) in order to be eligible to be scheduled for shifts.

Teens who complete the LIT Program are eligible to serve at other recreation programs sponsored by McKinleyville Parks & Recreation including the Kids' Club After School Program and Breakout, our School Break Daycamps. Service and Leadership look great on resumés and job applications. Several former

LIT's have become paid Recreation Leaders at McKinleyville Parks & Recreation. Take advantage of this great learning opportunity.

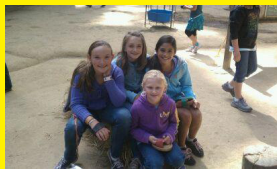

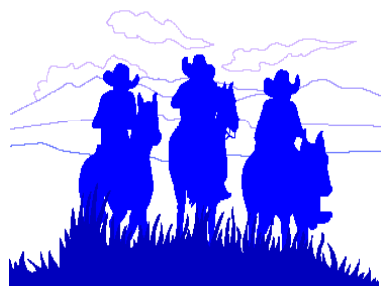
